

Navajo OSHA - Education and Training

Training Request Form

This course covers OSHA standards, policies, and procedures in General Industry (1910) or Construction Industry (1926). Topics include scope and application of the OSHA General Industry (1910) or Construction Industry (1926) - Standards, Safety and Health Principles, and special emphasis on those areas in (1910) or (1926), which are most hazardous. Upon course completion students will have the ability to define general industry or construction industry terms found in each of the OSHA Standards, identify hazards which occur in either general or construction industries, locate and determine appropriate OSHA Standards, policies, and procedures, and describe the use of the OSHA Standards and regulations to supplement an ongoing safety and health program. NOSHA training staff will provide training classes at workplaces, based on availability and permitting schedule, for class size of at least 10 students. NOSHA will train need a class of 5 or more to conduct Training courses.
